How Can I Best Promote Great Commission Day to My Congregation?



The resources in this packet have been developed to assist you in this process. The bulletin inserts can be used either in the weeks leading up to or on the day of the offering. Some churches distribute them in advance so families can pray together about how God would have them respond. Other churches give advance notice of the offering so that congregants are prepared to respond on the day they receive the insert.

In addition, a [video](#) has been created to help you promote the event. It explains the need for critical mass among Alliance teams working in places where God is on the move. Tim Crouch, vice president for International Ministries, describes how these teams must be built up to carry the ministry forward. As the pastor, you have great flexibility regarding how and when you use these tools to help your congregational members understand and celebrate their role in sending Jesus to where "the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few" (Matthew 9:37).
